

Cannabis – Marijuana – THC Schedule I (No known medical use)

Slang: Pot, Grass, Weed, Joint, Roach, Thai Stick, Maui Wowie,
 Skunkweed, Ditch Weed, Sens, Sensemillas, Northern Lights, Ect.

Dosage: .5 grams (1/12th of a gram)

Marijuana is used near the end of their high in order to help the person come down from the use of a hallucinogenic drug. It will be used in a room usually called a “chill room” which is cooler than the dance floor.

The marijuana in use today, if compared to the marijuana used in the 60's, can be from 6 to 25 joints more potent per joint, because of the cross-pollination and hibernization of the marijuana. Effects can last up to 5 days with the user not realizing what effect it's having on them.

Effects on Driving:

Small amounts:

Poor concentration, slowed reaction times, tunnel vision, reduced ability to accurately judge time, speed and distance, slower adjustment of the eyes to change in light.

Large Amounts:

Missing stop signs and traffic lights, passing other vehicles without exercising sufficient caution, overlooking pedestrians and stopped cars, reacting poorly in traffic.

Effects on Learning/Work:

Regular use:

Attention, memory, ability to synthesize information, ability to clarify information, ability to separate irrelevant from relevant information, understanding of subtle shades of meaning.

Using before school/work:

Lower achievement, more delinquent behavior and aggression.
