

## **Ketamine**

## **Ketalar, Katajet, Ketaset Schedule III Drug – hallucinogen (Medical use can be addictive)**

Slang: “K”, Special K, Super K, Ket, Vitamin K, Kitt Katt, God, Jet, Honey Oil, Blast, Gas.

Dosage: .25 mg – 2.0mg powder

Ketamine is an anesthetic used for small animals (90%) and Human (10%). This Anesthetic is a soft hallucinogen and is usually used to rave parties in combination with other party drugs.

Ketamine is an anesthetic that takes you away from reality. The severities of its effects are directly related to the method of administration. Ketamine can be injected or snorted. Snorting is the most common way of use.

There are several stages of intoxication:

### Stage 1

Anesthetic, loss of willful movement and eventually becoming immobile, feeling waves of emotions.

### Stage 2

Agitation, paranoia, sensory distortions. May have bizarre and impulsive behavior and out-of-body experience, such as floating over your body, seeing aliens or persons that they know have died.

### Stage 3

Persons acts stoned and has flashbacks of the experience they just had, a feeling of being reborn out of the mother’s womb or flashes of white light.

Ketamine can be found in a liquid form that appears slightly thicker than water and also in a crystalline powder from that looks similar to cocaine (white powder). In a powder form it is used with a small cocaine spoon (holds .02 grams), long fingernail, or end of key.
